



2 Lectureships (Assistant Professors) in Diplomacy and International Relations.

Contract: 3 year - probationary period. Starting September 2012.

Salary: Commensurate with experience.

The Geneva School of Diplomacy and International Relations (GSD), in its current phase of rapid growth and consolidation as a leading institution in the field of diplomacy and international relations seeks, to appoint 2 assistant professors (Lecturers) in Diplomacy and International Relations.

These are open positions. Applications are welcome from across the aforementioned disciplines. However, preference may be given to applicants who can teach in the fields of democracy, human rights, governance, security, crisis management, political economy, geopolitics and political communication.

The successful candidates will have a proven ability to produce research of international quality, and will be expected to contribute to the teaching, administration, fundraising and research/publication profile of GSD. An initial 3 year contract (100%) will be offered. No relocation fees will be paid. Swiss permit or EU permit preferred.

GSD expects the successful applicants to hold a PhD by the time their employment commences in September 2012.

Evidence of an active research agenda, post-doctoral research, ability to mentor students and to supervise theses, ability to work with a highly multicultural group of students, flexibility, a very strong cross-disciplinary approach and quantitative methods are also important characteristics of the candidate. Practical field experience in strategic regions and evidence of acquisition of third-party funds are valuable assets.

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Electronic application/Documentation: 1) Updated CV with publications 2) letter of interest 3) evaluations of teaching 4) contacts of 3 academic references and 5) 2-3 samples of the most relevant publications.

Procedure.

Most suitable candidates will be shortlisted. The selection process will be defined by 3 components: a) interview b) presentation of research plans and how the candidate fits with the GSD research agenda and entrepreneurial spirit and c) a lecture.

Closing date: 1st of March 2012.

Screening of applications will begin on the 5th of March 2012.
